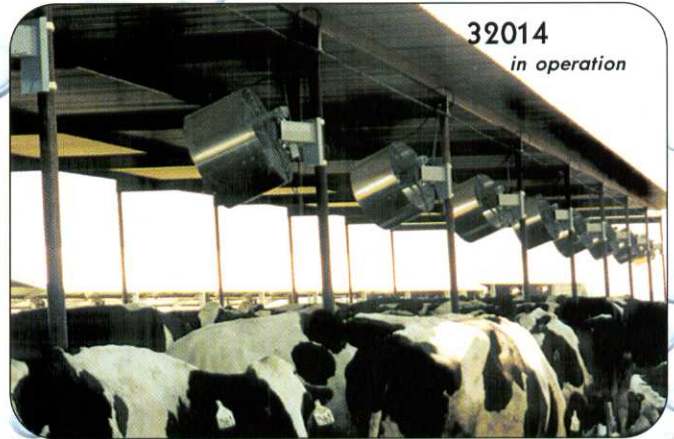

BIRD CONTROL

RJ-AG36

Mix with water and spray on turf area where geese graze

RJ-TP40

Spray on impoundments, decorative ponds, on temporary pools of water. Commercial fog for roost, airports, golf courses, railway terminal, electrical sub stations, or buildings

RJ-AG145

To limit damage to ripening cherries, blueberries, grapes, and strawberries caused by various birds, cedar waxings, brown thrashers, morning doves, gulls, house finches, american robins, cardinals, starlings, and many more
